2020 Spring Small-bore postal Competition

Please find attached the Wiltshire County Shooting Association (WCSA) Small bore Postal Competition entry forms for the upcoming 2020 Spring season.

Disciplines generally consist of 10 rounds shot over 6 months (January to June). Cards may be shot at any time. Between January 1st and June 30th 2020

Spring 2020 stickers to be sent out on receipt of entry.

COMPETITION NEWS

The inaugural rapid competition has been a great success, and we wish those who entered all the best for the season. This will be offered again for Spring 2020 and is expected to become a regular fixture.

We would like to be able to offer LSR options, but it's not a subject I'm familiar with. If someone would like to run the LSR side, set courses of fire, help with scoring etc. it would be greatly appreciated.

Tony Fisk Memorial Competition

For Spring 2020 we are starting the Tony Fisk Memorial open pistol competition in honour of our recently departed secretary. It is open to all pistols and split into 2 open classes;

Class 1 calibres less than 0.23

Class 2 everything else.

The aim is to start with a completely open competition for all comers, from 0.177 air pistols to .44 long barrellled pistols (with appropriate targets) to see the potential demand. The classes can be refined for later seasons when we have a measure of the demand.

This will be the first time the WCSA has opened up to this group of shooters.

Pistols to be shot standing.

GPDR

It is the responsibility of the Club Secretary/ Correspondent or individual completing the form to ensure each competitor has initialled the GPDR box. In doing so they agree to their name, score and club to be published. Data collected is only used for the legitimate management of the competition.

For Un-Initialled boxes we will publish competitor number, score and club.

Competition Formats

A number of competition formats are offered;

10 round competitions for 0.22 (prone and Bench-rest) target rifles.

5 round competitions for pistols, scored as the best 10 of 12 shots.

Sights

All cards to be shot using aperture or iron sights, except the Bench-rest discipline which require sights appropriate for the class entered.

Bench-rest Discipline

Rules for supporting the rifle shall be in line with the NSRA Bench Rest rules. The rifle fore-end may be supported at one point only using a free standing support not connected to the rifle. Objects may not be used to support the butt however the shooter may use their spare hand.

This discipline has 3 classes;

Class A Iron or aperture sights

Class B Scopes up to x8

Class C Scopes > x8

Prone Shooting Classes;

25yrd

Class A Average > 96 and above

Class B Average 94 to 95.9

Class C Average 92 to 93.9

Class D Average under 92

50m and 100yrd

Scoring will be based on the Mac Crae handicap system due to historically low entries.

Averages

The most recent WCSA averages will take precedence where available.

Medals shall be awarded as Prizes for the 2020 season.

SCORING

The NSRA have been running a number of Scorer Courses around the country in order that clubs have a qualified scorer. enabling clubs to score their own cards and forward results, so saving in postage costs and removing the chance of lost cards in the post.
